
Grand Prairie Municipal Courts Adaptive Reuse

McCASLIN ASSOCIATES designed a landmark building for the City of Grand Prairie. The City acquired a structure built in the early 1960s to house their municipal courts.

Reshaping both interior and exterior, McCASLIN ASSOCIATES added a bold new entry and grand palatial interior spaces while still meeting the City's strenuous practical requirements.
